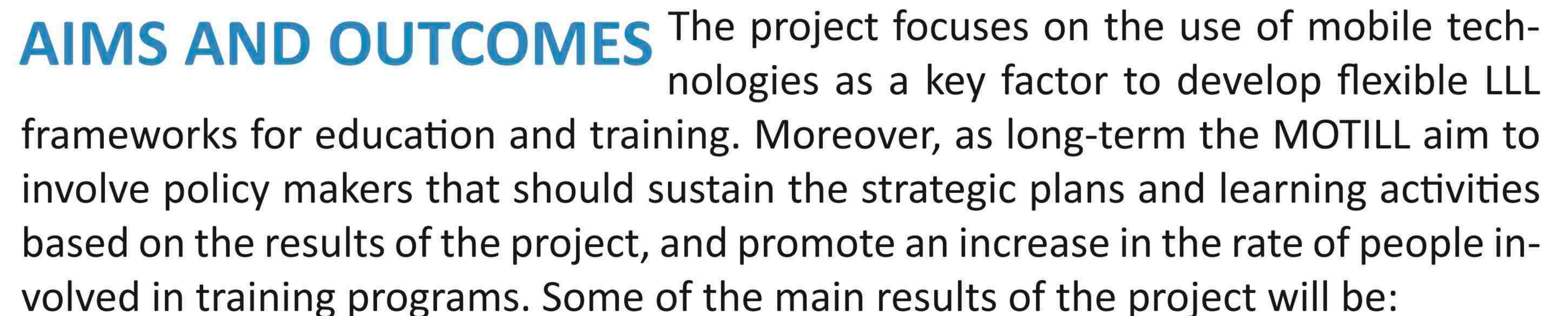




## WHAT IS THE MOTILL PROJECT?

MOTILL, which stands for “Mobile Technologies in Lifelong Learning: best practices”, is a one year project. It is funded with support from the European Commission within the National Lifelong Learning Strategies (NLLS) - Transversal programme - Key Activity 1: Policy Cooperation and Innovation of the Lifelong Programme 2007-2013.
